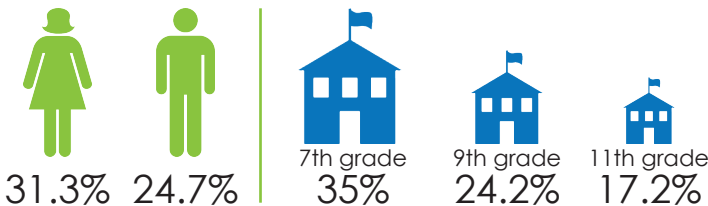

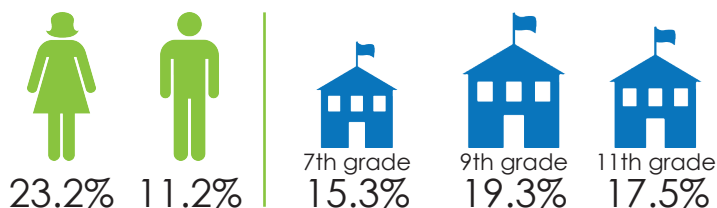
The MiPHY describes bullying this way: "when one or more students tease, threaten, spread rumors about, hit, shove, or hurt another student over and over again. It is not bullying when two students of about the same strength or power argue or fight or tease each other in a friendly way."

In the past year...

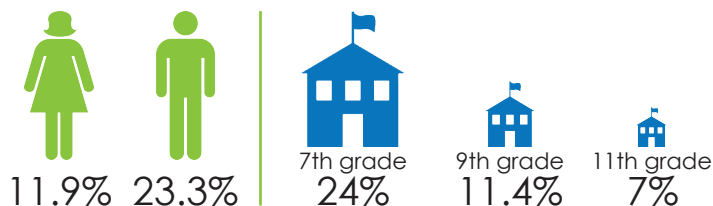
28.1% were bullied **on school property**.



17.4% were **electronically** bullied.



19.1% were in a **physical fight** on school property.

reported **two or more of the following things happened** to them during their life:

- death of a parent or caregiver
- mental abuse
- physical abuse
- sexual abuse
- saw violence in home or neighborhood
- lived with a person who had mental illness or attempted suicide
- lived with a person who was an alcoholic or used drugs
- lived with a person who went to jail or prison
